

“COOPERS ORIGINAL PALE STACKS OF CASH” ON-PACK PROMOTION

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Information on how to enter and the prizes form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
2. Entry is only open to Australian residents aged 18 years or over.
3. Employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter, Participating Retailer (as defined below) and agencies associated with this promotion are ineligible to enter. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1st cousin.
4. Entries into the promotion open on 01/04/2026 and close at 11:59pm AEST on 02/08/2026 (“**Promotional Period**”).
5. A participating retailer is any off-premise liquor retailer that stocks the Eligible Product (as defined below) and displays advertising material featuring this promotion (“**Participating Retailer**”).
6. To be eligible to enter, individuals must purchase, a specially marked carton (24x 375ml cans or 24x 375ml bottles) of Coopers Original Pale Ale (“**Eligible Product**”) from a Participating Retailer during the Promotional Period (“**Qualifying Transaction**”). It is the entrants responsibility to request a purchase receipt at the time of making a Qualifying Transaction, if one is not automatically provided to them.
7. To enter, individuals must then visit winwithcoopers.com.au/stacksofcash (or scan the QR code on pack), follow the prompts to the promotion entry page, input the requested details including the unique code (found on the inside of the Eligible Product) and submit the fully completed online entry form during the Promotional Period.
8. Upon submitting a valid entry in accordance with the above, individuals will be notified on-screen if they are a provisional winner of an instant prize. All valid entries received from winners and non-winners of an instant prize will be automatically placed in the major prize draw.
